Feb. 16: Crossover (all bills have to be passed out of side of origin on or by this date).

Feb. 19-20: Crossover Recess

March 1: Crossover date for resolutions.

March 23: Bills and resolutions must be out of committee.

April 26: 80th day of Session (session limited to 80 days unless approved by Governor).
